"We came up with the name 'Sunrise on Sunrise Brunch' for two reasons," said Jenn Pyle, manager, The Shout! House. "We're located on Sunrise Boulevard at Westgate City Center, and we have large windows facing a beautiful sunrise to the east. Our evening guests don't realize what a beautiful room this is during the day, and we're thrilled to show it off."
